Benjamin said the signing of the MoU is very important to ITCC shopping mall as it signifies the next step and evolution of the mall in having its own cinema under the prestigious and fastest growth cinema brand in Sabah, 10Star Cinemas.

"We are very pleased for signing this MoU with the target to start renovations within the next few months and to complete and open the cinema beginning 2025 before the blockbuster movie season sometime in March or April.

"With this new addition of 10 Star Cinemas as our cinema anchor tenant in ITCC shopping mall, Penampang we aim to improve our mall occupancy rate from the current 80pc to 100pc within one year.

"We are optimistic that ITCC shopping mall would continue to be the preferred shopping, leisure and entertainment complex in Penampang and nearby districts."

Shopping Mall, Penampang to operate screening movies until 3am as we provide similar time and facilities to our other cin-

emas in Tawau, which we received encouraging response." Onn Norshal told the press conference after the signing.

To a question, Tunku Yaacob said they chose Penampang to set up the cinema at ITCC shopping mall as they saw huge potential for development of entertainment in the district here.
