## \$4.5 million for Maryborough Olympic outdoor pool complex

A re-elected federal Labor Government will commit \$4.5 million for the Maryborough Olympic outdoor pool complex.

These upgrades are for one of Victoria's most historically significant sites and much-loved community spaces.

Martha Haylett, Senator Jana Stewart and Labor candidate for Mallee Greg Olsen have all welcomed the announcement for the funding commitment towards the pool.

"Maryborough deserves

an outdoor pool it can be proud of," Ms Haylett said.

"This election commitment will bring the pool complex back to life.

"I have been working closely with my federal colleagues to get this done and am committed to securing money from our State Labor

Government to save our outdoor pool too.
